The Trust offers grants to support the publication of local and regional studies and research and provides advice to authors on good practice. Particular attention will be paid to innovation in demonstrating the value of local history to our shared communities.



Grants are generally made to assist authors who wish to publish their work but assistance may also be offered for other platforms – county journals, pamphlets, pageants, video and film, exhibitions, photography, digital work and indexing for publication. It is essential that all work submitted is original and has copyright clearance. Grants are made to applicants resident in the nine counties of Ulster.



Since 2001 **Ulster Local History Trust** has organised biennial conferences on a range of themes including *Migration*, the *Plantation of Ulster*, the *Flight of the Earls*, the *Seventeenth Century Rebellions*, the *Decade of Centenaries* and the *Reformation*. In most cases, proceedings have been published in hard copy or online.



**Ulster Local History Trust** has engaged in a number of campaigns to preserve and record the townlands of Ulster.



**Since 1990 Ulster Local History Trust** has made over 100 grants of various kinds, including:
